In 1886, Robert Louis Stevenson first published the *Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*. Since its publication, the story of Mr. Utterson's relationship with Dr. Henry Jekyll and the chaos of Jekyll's medical experiments have enthralled audiences.
